Date: April 1, 2016

**Notice:** Penalty for non compliance with respect to waste management and ban on single use disposables

The is to draw the attention of all establishments within the ELCITA jurisdiction that a public notice is being issued in line with the authority vested on ELCITA from GoK – refer 'THE KARNATAKA MUNICIPALITIES ACT, 1964': 364 (F) and also by the order passed by the High Court of Karnataka on December 17, 2015 on segregation of waste and also by the notification issued by the Government of Karnataka dated March 11, 2016 banning the use of plastic covers and certain plastic items;

#### Definition of some of the terms shall be as follows:

- Waste generator: means any office/company/factory/hotels/shops/eateries
  restaurant/shopping complex/convention hall/place of worship/educational and other
  institutions/hostels/residential quarters, public or private entity or both which
  generates/accumulates municipal solid waste in their premises.
  - Private entity Those that are carrying on commercial activity coming under the purview of Shops and establishments Act / Trade License
  - Public entity Central government, State Government, Public sector undertakings,
     Parastatal agencies
- Service provider: An agency/ person who performs the function of collection, storage, segregation, transportation, processing and disposal of municipal solid waste in line with the Municipal Solid Waste (Management and Handling) Rules, 2000.
- Vendor: Any external licensed agent who is providing services to the waste generator such
  as juice center, caterer, food business operators/ petty food manufacturer within the
  premises of the waste generator.

#### Obligation and duty of waste generator:

• It shall be the obligation/duty of the waste generators to ensure that proper and scientific segregation of waste takes place in their respective premises without fail in compliance with the Municipal Solid Waste (Management and Handling) rules 2000 issued by Central Pollution Control Board. Different streams of waste to be stored in different color coded bins as per ELCITA guidelines. Steps should be taken to implement segregation at source however waste disposal should be after 100% segregation of the same.

- The Municipal Solid waste needs to be segregated as dry waste, wet waste which is (food waste and garden waste), reject waste- (which is inert and sanitary waste).
- Please refer to "ELCITA waste segregation guidelines". Also on ELCITA website Under Sustainability Solid waste management on ELCITA Website.

 Dry waste to be sent for recycling. Any other disposal method for dry waste will require approval from ELCITA.

Waste generators should refer to the table below for recommended, permitted banned material that can be used at Electronic city

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- The waste generator shall not mix wet waste with any other type of waste. Garden waste should be collected separately. Where waste generators have space within their premises, wet waste should be processed within the premises through composting/ bio-gas technique either partly or fully through licensed vendors following strict standards of hygiene and operation .Else waste generator should ensure that wet waste is either composted /sent to biogas plant or sent to piggery through ELCITA empanelled service providers.
- All waste generators are required to provide a suitable means for the disposal of sanitary
  waste in the ladies washroom such as Germicide Bins. This means that washroom cubicles
  should contain a sanitary unit or other form of bin suitable for the disposal of sanitary
  waste. Single pad micro incinerators electric or clay should not be used. Sanitary waste
  shall be sent to the service providers who dispose it as incineration through KSPCB
  authorized agencies.
- Construction and demolition waste needs to be collected separately and handed over to the authorized service provider
- Stringent measures should be taken to reduce reject waste generated on the premises of the waste generator.
- Traceability of the disposal methods of the MSW collected by the service provider lies with
  the respective waste generator by doing audits and ELCITA will support and facilitate the
  waste generator to work with empanelled service providers. ELCITA will inspect and cross
  check the service provider at regular intervals.
- The waste generators should abide by respective KSPCB rules for biomedical waste, E-waste
   ,Batteries and Hazardous waste and is to send all biomedical waste, E-waste, Hazardous
   waste ,Batteries to KSPCB authorized service provider and shall not be mixed with municipal
   solid waste. Visit KSPCB website for guidelines.
- The waste generators are required to do a self assessment and submit on an annual basis by
  June 30th, details as a per a ELCITA specified format, information on waste generated,
  process of segregation and storage, in-situ management, information on collection and
  transportation by service providers, training conducted. The generators should also be
  required to be open for scrutiny /inspection at any time by ELCITA including the records
  maintained. Refer Annexure -1
- Training Schedule to be maintained and followed- 4 training / year on efficient segregation
  of waste to the housekeeping and maintenance staff. Regular awareness programs should
  be conducted for employees.





- The waste generator shall also be under an obligation that all steps are taken to keep their
  premises hygienic. No waste of any kind shall be deposited at any time by the Waste
  generator/service provider/vendors on the streets, public spaces or vacant sites. The waste
  generator shall be responsible for the actions / inactions of Vendors operating in their
  premises with regard to this notification and penalties relating to segregation and disposal
  of waste.
- Shops and eateries should take appropriate steps to prevent littering around them to an area covering 25 meters by placing bins/speaking to customers and keeping their area clean.

#### Obligation and duty of service provider:

- Service providers should collect/transport and dispose waste in accordance with the MSW rules 2000.
- Service providers must pick up only segregated waste. All dry waste should be sent for recycling any other disposal method of dry waste requires ELCITA's approval; all wet waste should be either composted or sent to Biogas or piggery farms, sanitary waste to be incinerated and minimum reject waste to be disposed.
- Waste generators should make an MOU with the service provider and take responsibility to ensure that the service provider has got empanelment from ELCITA and a proper validity period in his empanelment and ensure renewal of empanelment with ELCITA at appropriate time.
- The empanelment is a set of guidelines for disposal as specified in this notification that
  the service provider agrees to abide by and wherein the service provider will declare his
  methods of disposal of waste. Service providers collecting waste from the waste
  generator should become an ELCITA empanelled service provider by signing the
  empanelment form and payment of an interest free refundable caution deposit of
  Rs.10,000
- When a service provider approaches ELICTIA for empanelment or a waste generator approaches ELCITA for empanelment of its service provider, ELCITA would provide a time frame for issue of empanelment during which ELCITA will due its due diligence of the service provider. The service provider can continue to service the waste generator until such time without empanelment





- ELCITA reserves the right to inspect /seek information from the service provider from time to time in the event any service provider is found to be flouting waste disposal practices which is not in line with the declared processes he will be penalized and /or debarred from collecting any form of waste in future from Electronic city and further the empanelment granted to the service provider would be withdrawn with immediate effect and the same intimated to all waste generators. If a waste generator engages service providers without empanelment from ELCITA, they would be penalized.
- ELCITA will publish the list of empanelled vendors on the ELCITA website that service providers can engage.

#### Obligation and duty of vendor:

Vendors in Waste Generators premises should sign-up with ELCITA that they will comply with waste segregation and disposal guidelines as specified in this notification. The format would be published on the ELCITA website .Waste generators should confirm that the vendor has signed the declaration with ELCITA before engaging them at their premises. ELCITA will give 3 months time from the date of final notification within which all existing vendors should sign the declaration.

#### Fines and Penalty:

- The ELCITA Inspector is empowered to levy spot fines as maybe prescribed for violation of any of the obligations or breach of duty as stated above:
- First time offenders would be warned and given a deadline to fall in line failing which
  the spot fines would be levied. They can seek ELCITA help within the timeline for
  training and guidance.

- Penalties on Waste generators need to be paid 15 days from date of notice failing which
  the penalty will be added to the property tax and if further breach of obligations after
  penalties beyond the 4th instance, suspension of trade licenses and with holding of tax
  receipts will be carried out until the waste generator proves that they have complied
  with all guidelines to the satisfaction of ELCITA. Violator's names will be published on
  the ELCITA website.
- Penalty of service provider to be paid 15 days from date of notice else empanelment stands canceled.

All Eateries, hotels, institutions, shops, large companies shall comply with the above by May 5, 2016 and all MSME shall comply by July 5, 2016.

#### Rewarding positive action:

Positive action by the by waste generator, service provider, vendor in following the guidelines of segregation and disposal methods, innovative ideas in reducing waste and use of alternative materials would be rewarded by certificate from ELCITA, awards announced periodically and their names published on ELCITA's website, social media.
